Support to live a healthier life.

WIC is a supplemental nutrition program for women, infants and children operated locally by Catholic Charities and other organizations.

Services are free of charge:

- Nutrition Education
- Breastfeeding Support
- Nutrition Counseling
- Prenatal & Postpartum Support
- Referrals
- Food Vouchers

You may be eligible if you:

- Are pregnant, breastfeeding, postpartum, OR
- Have an infant or child under 5 years old, AND
- Receive SNAP (Food Stamps), Temporary Assistance (TANF) of Medicaid or meet their income guidelines AND
- Live in New York State

WIC does NOT require U.S. citizenship, social security number, green card or legal residency to receive benefits.
